- Schedule and participate in introductory meetings with potential partners

- Assist in converting leads into training participants
- Provide regular updates on progress to the team
- Participate in bi-weekly update meetings with Program Operations Manager

This role requires a minimum 12-month commitment with a signed contract.

# **Key Responsibilities:**

- Conduct online research to identify new prospective major donors
- Gather publicly available data on potential major donors, including giving history, interests, affiliations, and capacity indicators
- Create concise, organized prospect profiles
- Prioritizing prospects based on potential alignment
- Maintain a tracking spreadsheet to record research findings and activity
- Collaborate with and update CSF staff
